 - ❑ Introduction to DAWs

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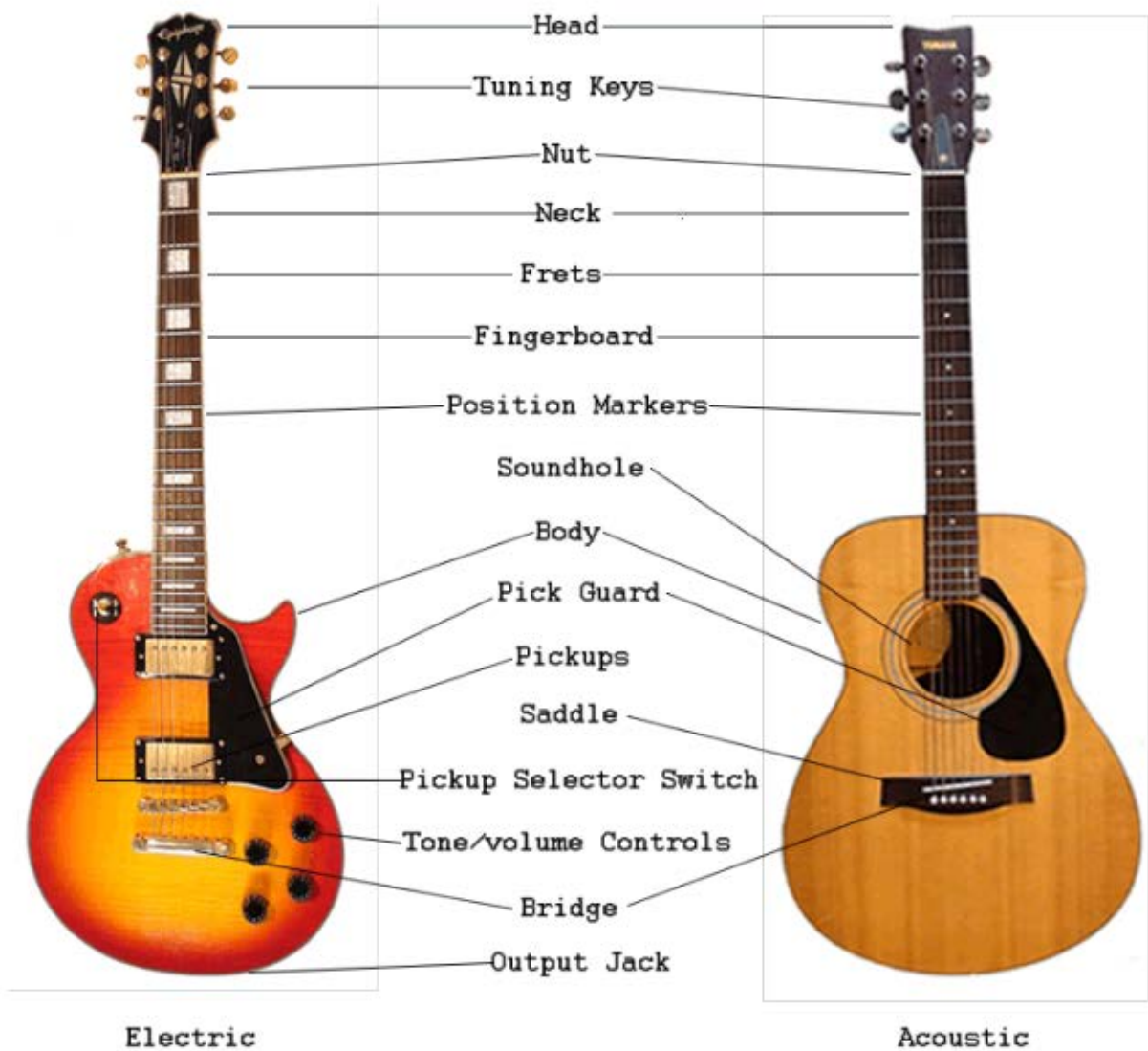

It is a good idea to familiarize yourself with the parts of the guitar, know them by name and function.

Instrument Knowledge

String Names and Tuning

The guitar has six strings, numbered 1-6 from thinnest/highest pitch to thickest/lowest in pitch. The standard tuning of the guitar is E A D G B E from thickest to thinnest string. A couple acronyms used to help memorize the names of the strings are:

Eddie **A**te **D**ynamite **G**ood **B**ye **E**ddie

Elephants **A**nd **D**onkeys **G**row **B**ig **E**ars
